Nominees will be judged on the following criteria:

- 1) Proven leadership abilities in promoting increased access to healthcare by Maine residents.
- 2) Evidence that their efforts have led to the actual provision of healthcare services to the underserved.
- 3) A deep commitment to the goal of healthcare access by Maine residents.
