# ***NOURISH TO FLOURISH: CULTIVATING HEALTHY COMMUNITIES FOR TODAY AND THE FUTURE***

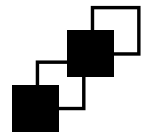


***The 2026 conference will take place on October 1st at the Augusta Civic Center.***

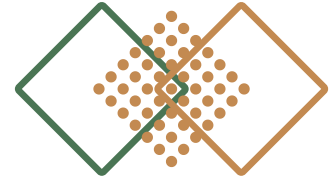

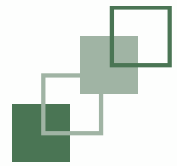
